



Quick Tech Productivity Pointers

In this month's edition, we continue with the tips to help you benefit from Windows 11. This month, we overview the "In Box" Apps you get with the latest iteration of Windows. Some are new, some are improved and others are revisions of long time standards. To find most of the apps, open the start icon in the lower left corner and click "all apps."

What's been added?


- Power Automate Desktop (PAD) It's easiest to think of this as a Windows Macro Scripting and Recorder utility. Imagine you have a series of steps you follow every time you open Windows, so you create a script to automatically run certain programs or files which you use every day. It could be a series of programs or files OR a series of steps within an application to complete a task such as an automated search in a database. There are two thoughts to share about this though... If you can program it in PAD, then you could most likely do the same in the program itself or setup automatic opens to occur in the Windows Startup. Either way, it is still a powerful tool (p.s.: it is also used by bad actors, so some of your security programs may try to stop it from running).
- Microsoft Office App is the famous red icon you see preinstalled on your Windows Start page and start menu. Although you may be using a full suite of Microsoft tools, this will allow you to open all of them within the same

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interface—think of it as a "single pane of glass." When you look for it in the menu, it's under "Office" with this icon, ① . As long as you have a current Microsoft subscription, you may also use this to install the full Office on your PC.



- Mail app is a feature rich eMail client. It fills the absence of Outlook Express from earlier versions of Windows. It will support multiple folders with different eMail accounts. You can even link all inboxes in a single location. Aside from these features, you also get colorful new images for your background. It's not Outlook. It does not have the ability to setup rules for your messages nor does it support extensions such as "Zoom invite," but if you are looking for value without added cost, this may work.
- Calendar app is incorporated into the same interface as the Mail app. Just click in the lower left corner and you can launch it. The Calendar allows you to view by day, week, month and year. It also allows you to consolidate other calendars to see all of them in a single view. A nice add is when you setup an event, you are able to use Teams as an Online Meeting provider.
- Calculator app has been around for a long time, but now it has more options that it will support for you. Click on the hamburger () the upper left corner. When you do, a new world will open up to you with a list of applied uses for it such as date calculation, currency conversions, graphing, volume, length, weight & mass, temperature, energy, area, speed, time, power, pressure and angle to name a few. Now that you have some new toys to play with, go experiment with them and see if having them on your computer reduces desk clutter or
