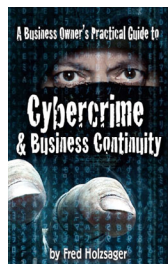

Around 37% of businesses now utilize AI in the workplace, according to a survey conducted by Gartner. Ronin was hacked for \$540 million, and Crypto.com was hacked for \$33 million worth of cryptocurrencies.

While cyber attacks on big businesses make national news, small businesses are targeted more often since their cyber security defenses aren't as strong. That being said, it's imperative you ensure your business has efficient cyber security practices in place, so you won't have to worry as much about cyber attacks.

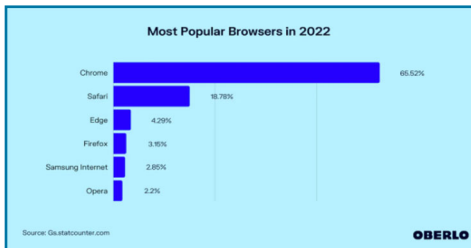

Quick Tech Productivity Pointers

Google Chrome has been the number 1 browser. So, in 2020, Microsoft completely revamped Edge.



Now, it is based on the same Chromium-based platform as Google Chrome and Opera. This means the extensions which you were used to in Chrome are now available in Edge too!

Do you know what an extension is?

As you use Edge, you should notice an icon (below) used to designate "Manage Extensions." It is found between the right of the address bar and the left of your profile picture. In this image, you see the icon for LastPass. As you 'stretch out' your browser, the



more icons you may see. If you don't see it, simply click on the Extensions icon to see and manage them. If you don't notice the extensions icon, you may click on the "..." (ellipsis), then click extensions. If you haven't figured it out yet, an extension is an application within the browser like Adobe Acrobat or Microsoft Outlook—the app icon is shown within your browser and the app runs in the browser, too!

How does Google differ from Edge with Privacy?

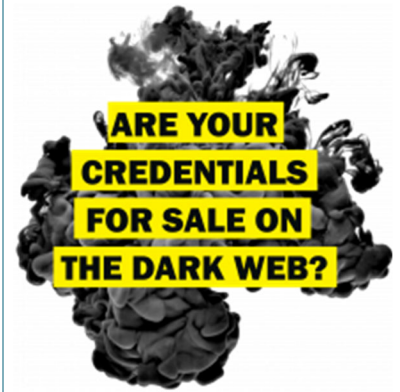
Google Chrome (and YouTube) are designed to collect your information and online history. They

use it to sell and to market to you. Microsoft is a bit less aggressive with regards to marketing. After you open Settings, click on the "≡" in the Settings in the upper left corner, then click on "Privacy, Search and Services." Here, you will find an option of **Tracking Prevention** with 3 choices:

Basic, Balanced (default) and Strict. Curious about who is tracking you? Click on the **Blocked trackers** and you will see *How many times the tracker was blocked and how many sites it was seen on.* On the right side, if you click the ">", it will display which site the tracker originated from. If you actually don't want to impose such restrictions, you may even disable the options.

Besides the **Clear browsing data** (history, passwords, cookies and more), you have a special **Privacy** setting where you may opt to send "**Do Not Track**" requests as well as **Allow/Deny** sites from checking if you have payment methods saved. Because Microsoft also has its own security apps, they have included some nice **Security** options: **Microsoft Defender SmartScreen** prevents you from visiting malicious sites and performing downloads; **Block potentially unwanted apps** blocks downloads of low-reputation apps that may cause unexpected behaviors; and **Website Type Protection** to warn you if you mistype a site address and may be directed to a potentially malicious site. By the way, these sites are often referred to as a **Domain Doppelgänger** (sites with almost the same names (e.g., "tech4now" vs "tech4n0w")). These errors are often associated with **Typoglycemia**—when your brain reads what it wants to and may result in a user going to the wrong website.

We hope these *Edge* pointers prove helpful to you and also enable you to surf the Web more safely.
