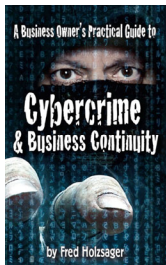

Your Password Hygiene and Why It Is So Critical

We realize, for years, this column of the newsletter has long been the residence of some humorous writing. In light of the fact that this month holds **World Password Day**, we felt it incumbent upon us to share ideas on how you may fortify and simplify your ability to make better, stronger and easier codes to work with.

• **Using a password is like having a locked front door.** You need to realize a door with a lock is more secure than one without. Your password is the foundation of an established security model. To make a strong password, give yourself a moment to think about something you want to memorialize. You have a dog named, "Fido" and the dog is black. He wears a collar with a college logo and his family loves to ski. Now, create a password:

"FiDo=Love_Black+RedCollar@+h3SLoPes"—you have just created a 36 character long password you can recall and type easily. You have incorporated upper & lower case, numbers and symbols to make it very strong, but since it is linked to an image you can envision, you can successfully apply a strong password to your use.

• **Now, you hold the key to generating a master password you can use with a password manager.** A **Password Manager (PM)** is a tool that allows you to consistently create strong, long passwords that are


hack resistant and easily retained in a secure repository accessible on your computer, phone or tablet. It encrypts the storage of these codes so they are inaccessible without a Master Password. Mind you, loss of the Master Password can be devastating; however, you may also write it down and store it in a secure location for you or your family to access in an emergency situation.

The PM may be purchased with a security package from a vendor such as Norton or McAfee. It may also be bought from a vendor that sells Security-centric applications such as *Keeper*, *DashLane*, *Passportal* or others in the same industry. There are many online sources to review them and you may often get free trials to test them in your own environment. **We do NOT recommend using the PM in your browsers—they are, typically, insecure and easy to breach.** As you become accustomed to the PM, you may wonder how you managed without one up until now. The beauty of the PM is you have the same password visible to you on every platform. When you update it, the change is GLOBAL, so you are never using the "old" password. Furthermore, the PM will generate new secure complex passwords for you AND will retain a number of prior instances in the event something goes wrong when you change them. Now, you may have a unique password for every account login you have enabling you to be more secure. ☺

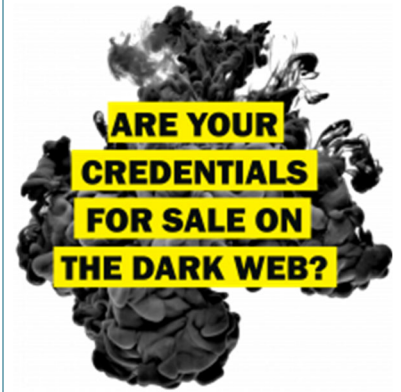
Quick Tech Productivity Pointers

Let's review some simple tasks that can save you time in your daily actions:

1. You just closed a tab in the browser, but now you need to open it again—Right click on the tab bar and select, "Reopen closed tab" (Ctrl+Shift+T) or (Command+Shift+T on a Mac).
2. Next time you get a text that is SPAM and you don't want to receive them anymore... Instead of swiping to delete, choose "Report Junk" or forward the text to 7726 (S-P-A-M) for that spammer to "go away!"
3. Do you want to create documentation and want to include a screenshot of the action? Just press **⌘ + Shift + S**, the screen grays and you get a "+" to set a corner, "marquee" the portion of the screen you wish to capture by clicking in a corner with your mouse, then drag it to enclose the image you want. Once you release the left mouse button, your image is copied to the "clipboard." If you use OneNote or Word, you can paste the image into a document simply by pressing Ctrl+V (paste). It also works in Outlook (since Outlook uses Word for editing). By the way, if you capture too large an image, you can often "crop" it to adjust it. Simply click on the image and right-click for a context menu:  (The CROP icon is in the **RED** box.)

4. Did you ever feel like splitting the screen to show more than one application in a side-by-side orientation. Use the Windows key (⊞) + the cursor key) to move the app to a particular side (←→↵). Try it now, you will see ACTIVE program move in the direction of the arrow key you click.
5. What happens when you have most of your applications (shortcuts) stored on the desktop and you want to open one, but the program you are running covers your desktop? Try the Windows key + D (desktop). To restore it, simply press the same combination again.
6. If you accidentally delete a file in File Explorer (visit Recycle Bin) or inadvertently clear some thought you've typed in a document, but want to restore it, click CTRL+Z (Undo). This works wonders. Oops! Want to redo it, click CTRL-Y. *I suggest you try it before you depend on it.*
7. If you find your computer is running slow on a regular basis, you can take a look at the Task Manager (Right click on Taskbar to launch) or CTRL+ALT+DELETE for the menu option "Task Manager." When you look at the Processes page, you can see what is running "high" on CPU, Disk, Memory and Network. This helps you to identify a resource hog. Once you have that, open **SETTINGS** (⊞+I) > **Apps** > **Startup** allows you to suppress startups.
