Have you been hearing more about email authentication lately?

There is a valid reason for it—the prevalence of phishing as a major security threat. Phishing continues as the main cause of data breaches and security incidents. This has been the case for many years.

A major shift in the email landscape is happening. The objective is to combat phishing scams. Email authentication is becoming a requirement for email service providers. It's crucial to your online presence and communication to pay attention to this change.

Google and Yahoo are two of the world's largest email providers. They have implemented a new DMARC policy that took effect in February 2024. This policy essentially makes email authentication essential. It's targeted at businesses sending emails through Gmail and

Yahoo Mail.

But what's DMARC, and why is it suddenly so important?

The Email Spoofing Problem

Imagine receiving an email seemingly from your bank. It requests urgent action. You click a link, enter your details, and boom—your information is compromised. The common name for this is **email spoofing**.

It's where scammers disguise their email addresses. They try to appear as legitimate individuals or organizations. Scammers spoof a business's email address. Then they email customers and vendors pretending to be that business.

These deceptive tactics can have devastating consequences on companies.



These include:

- · Financial losses
- · Reputational damage
- · Data breaches
- Loss of future business

Unfortunately, email spoofing is a growing problem. It makes email authentication a critical defense measure.

What is Email Authentication?

Email authentication is a way of verifying that your email is legitimate. This includes verifying the server sending the email. It also includes reporting back unauthorized uses of a company domain.

Email authentication uses three key protocols, and each has a specific job:

• **SPF (Sender Policy Framework):** Records the IP addresses authorized to send email for a domain.

• DKIM (DomainKeys Identified Mail):

Allows domain owners to digitally "sign" emails, verifying legitimacy. This may also enable you to send email using an authorized proxy.

• DMARC (Domain-based Message Authentication, Reporting, and Conformance):

Gives instructions to a receiving email server including what to do with the results of an SPF and DKIM check. It also alerts domain owners that their domain is being spoofed.

SPF and DKIM are protective steps. DMARC provides information critical to security enforcement.

SPF and DKIM are protective steps. DMARC provides information critical to security enforcement. It helps keep scammers from using your domain name in spoofing attempts.

Why Google & Yahoo's New DMARC Policy Matters

Both Google and Yahoo have offered some level of spam filtering but didn't strictly enforce DMARC policies.

- Starting in February 2024, the new rule took place. Businesses sending over 5,000 emails daily must have DMARC implemented.
- Both companies also have policies for those sending fewer emails.

These relate to SPF and DKIM authentication.

Look for email authentication requirements to continue. You need to pay attention to ensure the smooth delivery of your business email.

The Benefits of Implementing DMARC:

- · Protects your brand reputation
- · Improves email deliverability
- Provides valuable insights

The recording of SPF, DKIM and DMARC records occur in your DNS Registry Settings. DMARC processing often involves a paid for service.

QUICK SECURITY TIP: How you process your garbage can significantly affect your privacy and identity. If you decide to get rid of older copies of investment reports or other private documents, we strongly encourage you to shred them. A cross-cut shredder can be acquired in most office supply stores for prices ranging from under \$100 to higher. Having important papers shredded to maintain privacy is key. 

Quick Productivity Tips

Windows 11 has a feature that some people love and others may find annoying... the Widget Screen (国+W). Whenever you open it, you will see a selection of various feature articles and photos. It ranges from News and Weather to the latest fashions and a plethora of promotions for everything under the sun.


I know that I don't use Widgets, in general, but if you want to follow some stock tickers or are engaged with Games, it can be an addictive distraction. Not only are the individual items a time sucking distraction, but the notifications add to the damage.

If you find the notifications constantly summon your attention away from more productive activities, you might want to visit the upper-right corner of the Widget screen and click on the settings gear (), then you will see the list of choices you may modify within this applet. May I suggest you visit the "Notifications" section and disable both of the options:



NOTE: It is best to read this column while at your computer for a better understanding of the content presented. *Enjoy!*

The other modification you may wish to make is the "Show or Hide Feeds." When you decide to hide your feeds, the items shown will reduce by a dramatic level from scrollable list and choices to five (5) or six (6) items. [Widgets will have to close when you elect to hide your feed.]



In fact, should you wish to reduce the screen in the dramatic way, you can always click on the ellipsis for more options. This way, if you don't want to see the Traffic Incidents in your area or the Games options, you may hide them.

If, on the other hand, you wish to add more to your stock list or your revert to what you had earlier or choose to add new items, click on the PLUS SIGN (+) in the upper-right corner of the Widgets main screen. Then, you may choose to add items such as: A personal **Focus Session** timer, Instant Play (Games), Microsoft Feed (articles of Microsoft's choosing), Outlook Cal**endar** (reminders of appointments and special days), **Sports** (scores etc.), **Tips** (shortcuts and other ideas for more engagement with your PC), **To Do** (Your Task List), Traffic, Watchlist and Weather. In fact, there is also an option for "Find more widgets." So, now you have a basic intro to using your Windows Widgets. We hope this helps you be more productive.
