



How To Use AI For Business Productivity

- **Data Leakage**. In order to operate, AI models need data. This can be sensitive customer data, financial information, or proprietary work products. If this information needs to be sent to third-party AI models, there must be a clear understanding of how and when this information will be used.
- **Shadow AI**. Many employees use AI tools for their daily work. This might include generative platforms or online chatbots. Without proper vetting, these can cause compliance risks.
- Overreliance and Automation Bias. Many users consider AI-generated content to always be accurate when, in fact, it is not. Relying on this information without checking it for accuracy can lead to poor decision-making.
- Secure AI and Productivity

The steps necessary to secure potential security risks when utilizing AI tools are relatively straightforward.

• Establish an AI Usage Policy.

It is critical to set limits and guidelines for AI use prior to installing any AI tools. Be sure to define approved AI tools and vendors, acceptable use cases, prohibited data types and data retention practices.

- Choose Enterprise-Grade AI Platforms. One way to secure AI platforms is by ensuring that they offer the following: GDPR, HIPAA, or SOC 2 compliant, data residency controls, do not use customer data for training and provide encryption for data at rest and in transit.
- **Segment Sensitive Data Access**. Adopting rolebased access controls (RBAC) provides better restrictions on data access. It allows AI tools access to only specific types of information.
- Monitor AI Usage. It is essential to monitor AI usage across the organization to understand what and how information is being accessed and including

- AI for Cybersecurity. One of the primary uses of AI tools is the detection of cyber threats. Organizations use AI to detect threats, deter email phishing, protect endpoints, and automate responses.
- Train Employees About Responsible Use.

An unfortunate truth about humans is that they are the weakest link in the chain of cyber defense. Even the strongest defensive stance on cyber threats can be undone with a single click by a single user.

QUICK SECURITY TIPS: Account Takeover (ATO) Scams The security company, Splunk, recently released an eBook on the Top 50 Cyber Security Threats. Amonast those listed was the ATO. This is primarily a scam affecting organizations that are responsible for the accounts of others, such as Banks, Investment Firms, and Credit Card Issuers. The **ATO** is one of the most harmful attacks used—the third-party is the one that suffers since the targeted accounts protect cash, stocks, bonds and other transactional instruments. The attackers pose as account owners, employees, or customers on an account. Once the account is breached, the "contents" are emptied. The eBook reported, "in 2022 alone, 84% of organizations fell victim to identity-related breaches." The need for using the correct technologies and policies are stressed (e.g., zero trust and vendor management). If you use an identity-centric approach, you will see how passwords and multifactor authentication help. Often phishing and malware are used to capture the data (if it's not sourced through a breach), so be careful: know what looks wrong may be wrong, and read before you click. Other ways to reduce the your vulnerability include restricting the personal data you post; give yourself and staff a standard operating procedure when processing payments, and avoid suspicious links.

Quick Productivity Tips

This month, we continue with tips to give you insights into Windows 11. This issue will cover more **Applications** (a.k.a., "**Apps**") to enhance your productivity.

Does your machine take a while to load up?! If you find yourself waiting too long before you start up your machine, you might need to prevent them from starting up automatically.


Do you need to work on your computer in a language other than English? Simply, open up the Settings screen, then click on Time & language. Not only will you have access to tell the computer which language or regional formats you wish to set, but you can also adjust your Date & time in the event you travel extensively and need to have your computer make adjustments (By the way, if you allow it to detect your location, it can set time zone for you automatically AND adjust for Daylight Saving time, too!). Don't forget to have the time and date show in the bottom right corner of your screen (System Tray).

Back in the **Language & region** section, you may choose a Windows display language. In order to add a new Preferred Language, click "Add a language" and you will see a listing that you may type in a language name, scroll to find one. Next to each language, there are icons to reflect how it can be used in Windows 11. The list is extensive, but as shown in the exhibit on the right, most limitations are related to Text-to-speech or Speech recognition.

Regions allow you to have the number, currency and Date & time formats adapt to the current or preferred location specified.

Related settings give you even more granular control over your machine by displaying calendars in specific format or enabling spell check and autocorrect to help you type. It even may provide text suggestions.

NOTE: It is best to read this column while at your computer for a better understanding of the content presented. *Enjoy!*



If you scroll down further, each section also has a Related support area where hyperlinks to full articles are listed to give you even greater options for insights.

Typing will allow you to customize your *touch* keyboard and typing preferences. You can also set actions for when using a *physical* keyboard. There are also a number of features you may enable to address:

- Multilingual text suggestions
- Autocorrect misspelled words
- Highlight misspelled words
- Typing insights

There is even a related setting that allows you to train Windows 11 (on a touch screen or tablet) how to recognize your handwriting and even shortcuts in your notes such as "ASAP" into "As soon as possible."

Finally, you may also modify **Speech** by selecting a local accented voice for reading out loud, indicate the language you will speak to your computer and adjust the speed used for it to communicate out loud. You can even add voices, male or female from near or far.
